McLean County Commission Proceedings Tuesday, June 6, 2023

The first regular June meeting of the Board of Commissioners was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Vice-Chairperson Steve Lee. Present were Commissioners Steve Lee and Barry Suydam. Also present were Auditor Beth A. Knutson; Deputy Auditor Diane L. Blumhagen; Road Superintendent James Grey; Chief Deputy Lori A. Foss; and James Falcon of NorDak North Publishing. Absent was County Commissioner Steve Cottingham.

Moved by Suydam, seconded by Lee, to approve the minutes of the previous regular meeting held on May 23, 2023, as submitted. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam and Lee. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Steve Cottingham. Motion carried.

Foss requested approval to purchase six new replacement Toughbook laptops for the Sheriff's Department from Route1. The total cost is \$14,760.78.

Moved by Suydam, seconded by Lee, to authorize the purchase of six Toughbook laptops for the Sheriff's Department as presented. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam and Lee. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Steve Cottingham. Motion carried.

Grey presented an update on department operations reporting that work on County Road 2 by Max will be completed June 6, 2023, and graveling across the county continues.

Grey presented a boring request from RTC Networks requesting to bore 14th St NW in SW¹/₄ of Section 20, Township 148 North, Range 84 West, and NW¹/₄ of Section 29, placing fiber inside plastic conduit pipe to provide services to DeTrobriand Bay Estates.

Knutson presented the Uncollected Tax List for years 2020-2022 showing a total of \$1,203,947.08.

Knutson presented the budget narrative for period ending May 31, 2023. She presented data showing property tax collections are at 92% collected including 96% with discount for 2023 or \$18,643,272.93; government reimbursement revenues totaled \$892,534.66 compared to \$890,981.14 in 2022; fees and miscellaneous revenues totaled \$754,906.02 compared to \$673,083.44 in 2022; and expenditures were at 30.51% of total budget for 2023.

Knutson presented the current list of delinquent tax payers owing more than \$4,000.00 showing 41 taxpayers owing \$433,362.45 in back taxes.

Vice-Chairperson Lee recessed the meeting at 9:00 a.m.

Vice-Chairperson Lee reconvened the meeting at 9:11 a.m.

Foss rejoined the meeting to requested approval to purchase Microsoft Office software for the six new Toughbooks from NRG. The total cost is \$1,899.06.

Moved by Suydam, seconded by Lee, to authorize the purchase Microsoft Office software from NRG as presented. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam and Lee. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Steve Cottingham. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairperson Lee recessed the meeting at 9:12 a.m.

## McLean County Board of Equalization Meeting Tuesday, June 6, 2023

The Board of Equalization meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Vice-Chairperson Steve Lee. Present were Commissioners Steve Lee and Barry Suydam. Also present were: Auditor Beth A. Knutson; Tax Director Todd Schreiner; Property Assessor Ryan Oberg; Property Assessor Elizabeth Patterson; and Deputy Auditor Diane L. Blumhagen.

Schreiner stated that sales are the driving force behind what the county does along with the current market. He reported that overall, agricultural (ag) land in 2023 increased 1.31% compared to 2022 values. Ag values are assessed according to soils and not sales or current market. The figures used are derived from NDSU Extension Office located in Fargo, North Dakota. There were 51 commercial sales used in the sales ratio for McLean County with an overall percentage of 93.9%. There were 118 residential sales used in the sales ratio from McLean County with an overall percentage of 92.4%. Schreiner informed the commission that the ratio was initially at 88% and to achieve the acceptable rate set by the State of North Dakota between 90% and 100% of value residential structures in McLean County were increased by 5%.

Moved by Suydam, seconded by Lee, to approve the 2023 market values for commercial in the amount of \$178,853,234.00 and final ratio of 93.90% as presented. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam and Lee. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Steve Cottingham. Motion carried.

Moved by Suydam, seconded by Lee, to approve the 2023 market values for residential in the amount of \$773,980,304.00 and final ratio of 92.40% as presented. Discussion followed. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam and Lee. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Steve Cottingham. Motion carried.

Moved by Suydam, seconded by Lee, to approve the 2023 overall ag values in the amount of \$765.03 per acre as presented. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam and Lee. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Steve Cottingham. Motion carried.
