The first regular June meeting of the Board of Commissioners was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Chairperson Steve Lee. Present were Commissioners Lee, Steve Cottingham, and Barry Suydam. Knutson presented the budget narrative for period ending May 31, 2022. She presented data showing property tax collections are at 92% collected including 96% with discount for 2022 or \$18,340,737.21; government reimbursement revenues totaled \$890,981.14 compared to \$942,789.06 in 2021; fees and miscellaneous revenues totaled \$673,083.44 compared to \$801,463.62 in 2021; and expenditures were at 35.90% of total budget for 2022.

Knutson presented the Uncollected Tax List for years 2019-2021 showing a total amount of \$955,187.62.

Knutson presented the current list of delinquent tax payers owing more than \$4,000.00.

Knutson updated the commissioners regarding the status of the current election.

Knutson discussed property owned by McLean County which include assessed specials. Discussion followed.

Grey rejoined the meeting.

Argabright and Johnson addressed the commissioners regarding the removal of a stop sign on 36th Ave. SW near Wolf Creek. Johnson requested the commission look into funding from North Dakota Game and Fish and the Army Corp of Engineers for road suppressant. Discussion followed which resulted in the Highway Department evaluating the speed sign placement along 36th Ave. SW, along with other options.

Tax Director Todd Schreiner and Property Assessor Elizabeth Patterson joined the meeting.

Chairperson Lee recessed the meeting at 9:56 a.m.

McLean County Board of Equalization Meeting Tuesday, June 7, 2022

The Board of Equalization Meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Steve Lee. Present were Commissioners Lee, Steve Cottingham, and Barry Suydam. Also present were: Auditor Beth A. Knutson, Tax Director Todd Schreiner, Property Assessor Elizabeth Patterson, Property Assessor Ryan Oberg, Deputy Auditor Diane L. Blumhagen, and Ethan Bender.

Schreiner stated that sales are the driving force behind what the county does along with the current market being followed. He reported that overall, agricultural (ag) land in 2022 reduced 1.5% compared to 2021 values. Ag values are assessed according to soils and not sales or current market. The figures used are derived from NDSU Extension Office located in Fargo, North Dakota. There were 76 commercial sales used in the sales ratio from McLean County with an overall percentage of 96.5%. There were 147 residential sales used in the sales ratio from McLean County with an overall percentage of 95.4%. Schreiner informed the commission that there was no overall large increase to values. Value increases in McLean County that did occur were due to new construction, improvements to property, current condition, and sales which accounted for a number of value adjustments to a number of lake and rural subdivision properties.

Moved by Cottingham, seconded by Suydam, to approve the 2022 market values for residential in the amount of \$719,243.91 as presented. Discussion followed from Bender regarding his received assessment letter regarding his assessed value. Oberg discussed the value of the Bender property. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam, Cottingham, and Lee. Motion carried.

Moved by Suydam, seconded by Cottingham, to approve the 2022 market values for commercial in the amount of \$155,541.35 as presented. Discussion followed. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Cottingham, Suydam, and Lee. Motion carried.

Moved by Cottingham, seconded by Suydam, to approve the ag values as presented. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Suydam, Cottingham, and Lee. Nay: None. Motion carried.
